A TYPE FAMILY BY FEÒRAG NÌCÈHRÌDE

The *Styl* family is inspired by a typeface used for the masthead of pioneering Dutch art magazine, *De Stijl*, in 1918. The original was considerably less legible than this (and I didn't know about the Dutch *ij* ligature back then), which explains why this font is called '*Styl*' and not '*Stijl*'

This version has been extensively reworked and includes a new, lighter, weight as the regular weight. The old weight is now bold. Styl Round looks a lot different after the redesign.

The character set includes support for virtually every language which can be written in Latin script and includes a selection of ligatures. These characters can be accessed by either choosing an appropriate keyboard layout in the International preferences panel, or via the Special Characters.../Glyphs menu option (the name seems to vary depending on the application).

This archive contains the TTF version of the font, which can be used on MacOS X, Linux and Windows. It includes the following files:

- **About Styl and Styl Round TTF.pdf** - this file.
- **Styl.ttf, Styl-Bold.ttf, StylRound.ttf and StylRound-Bold.ttf** - the font files. In MacOS X, double click on these to see a preview. Click on the "Install Font" button to install. For earlier versions of Mac OS, these files should go in the 'Fonts' folder in the System Folder. For other platforms, please refer to the documentation.

A Postscript flavoured OpenType version, suitable for use with Classic MacOS, is also available.

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
